

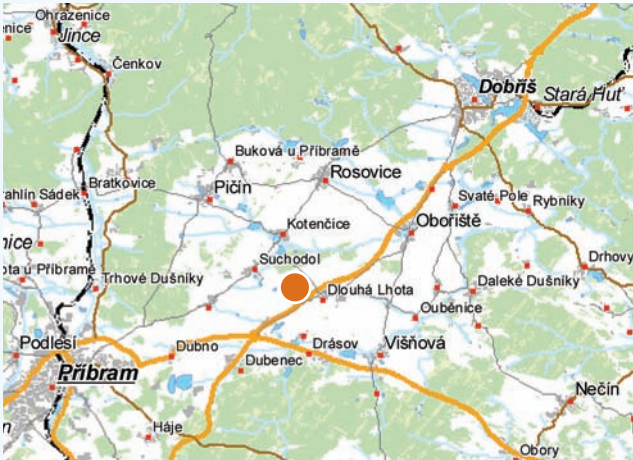

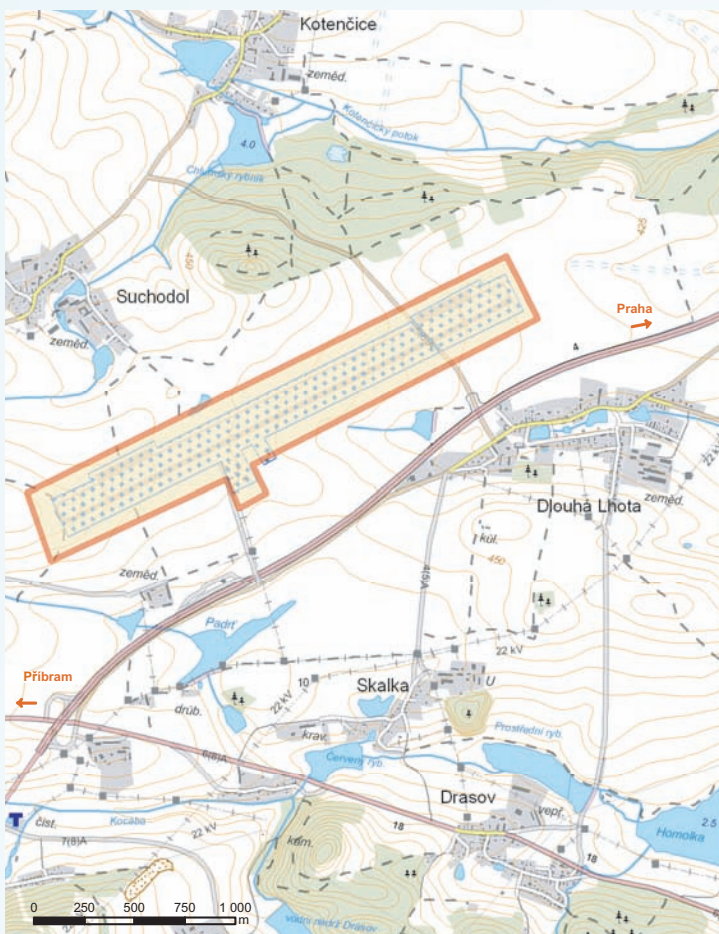
Příbram–Dlouhá Lhota Airfield 17 ha for sports – aviation, parachuting

Most of the airfield is located in the registration area of **Dlouhá Lhota**, which is 50 km southwest of Prague on the R4 expressway between Dobříš and Příbram.

The former military airfield, now operated by Letiště Příbram, s.r.o., is west of the R4 expressway, which is west of the developed area of Dlouhá Lhota. The airfield, currently used for aviation sports, could serve the local community as an air-taxi service with the option of manufacturing or sports and recreation.

Geographic and historical features

425 m above sea level • first documented in 1336 • chateau from around 1800, Gothic church of St John the Evangelist, renovated several times

Principal data

Area: 17 ha

Anticipated use: transport, sports/recreation

Zone location: west of the Dlouhá Lhota registration area, west of the R4 expressway, partly in the registration areas of Suchodol and Drásov

Current use and land ownership: Former military airfield, currently a national public airfield used for sport aviation, operated by Letiště Příbram, s.r.o. The airfield has two take-off and landing runways: 06/24 1,450 x 70 m grass surface, 06/24 1,450 x 30 m concrete surface. The runways are 2,500 m long and cannot be used for civil aviation due to the protective and security zones.

The airfield is used mainly for sports and for educational and leisure events (aviation shows, memorials, training for pilots and parachutists, etc.).

The airfield is owned by Letiště Příbram s.r.o. (with the exception of one hangar and one building owned by the Czech Army); the runways located on land that is 90% owned by private individuals (approx. 60) and 10% state-owned are still army property.

Municipal plan – regulations, restrictions

Zone use complies with the valid municipal plan (transportation site – airfield). The protection zone of the airfield does not extend into the developed area of the municipality.

The zone is affected by the boundary of the Příbram uranium fields.

Transportation

Roads: the airfield is accessible (ca 2 km) from the intersection of the R4 expressway Prague–Strakonice and Road I/18.

Railways: none in the vicinity – the nearest railway stations are Dobříš (10 km) and Příbram (10 km).

Infrastructure

Water: own source of water (well)

Sewer system: local, leading to a receptor

Electricity: 22 kV power line to the buildings

Natural gas: none
